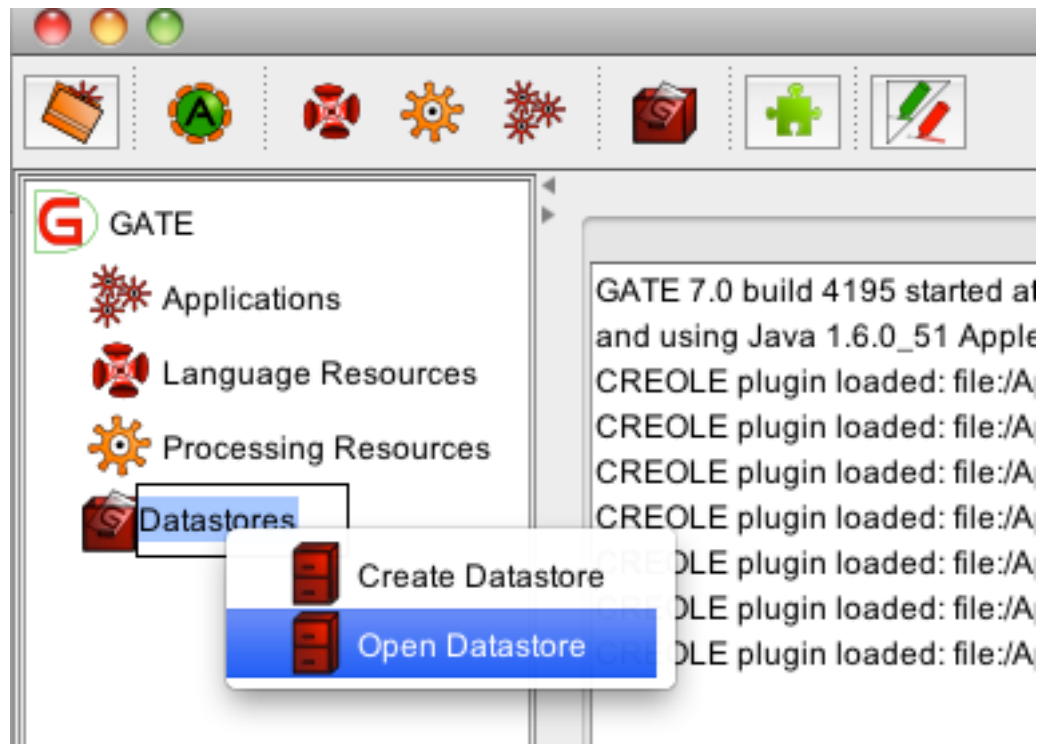

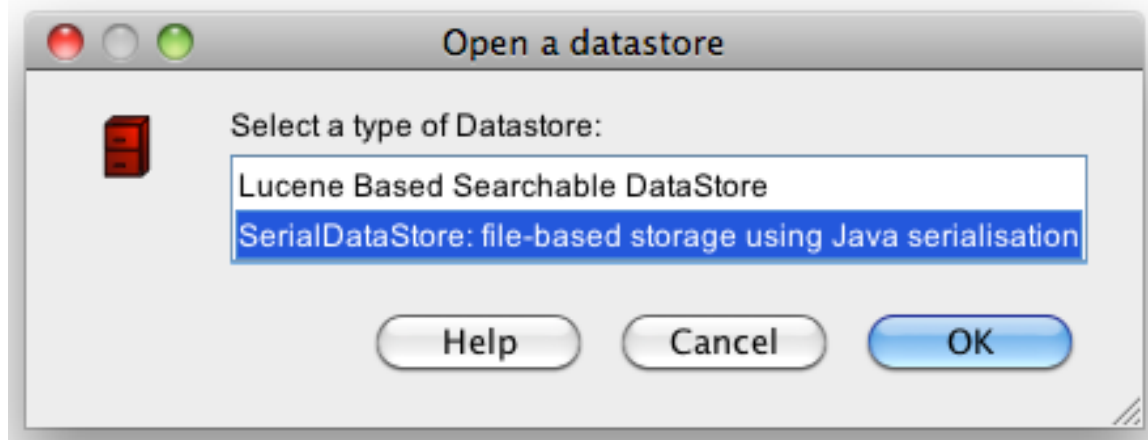

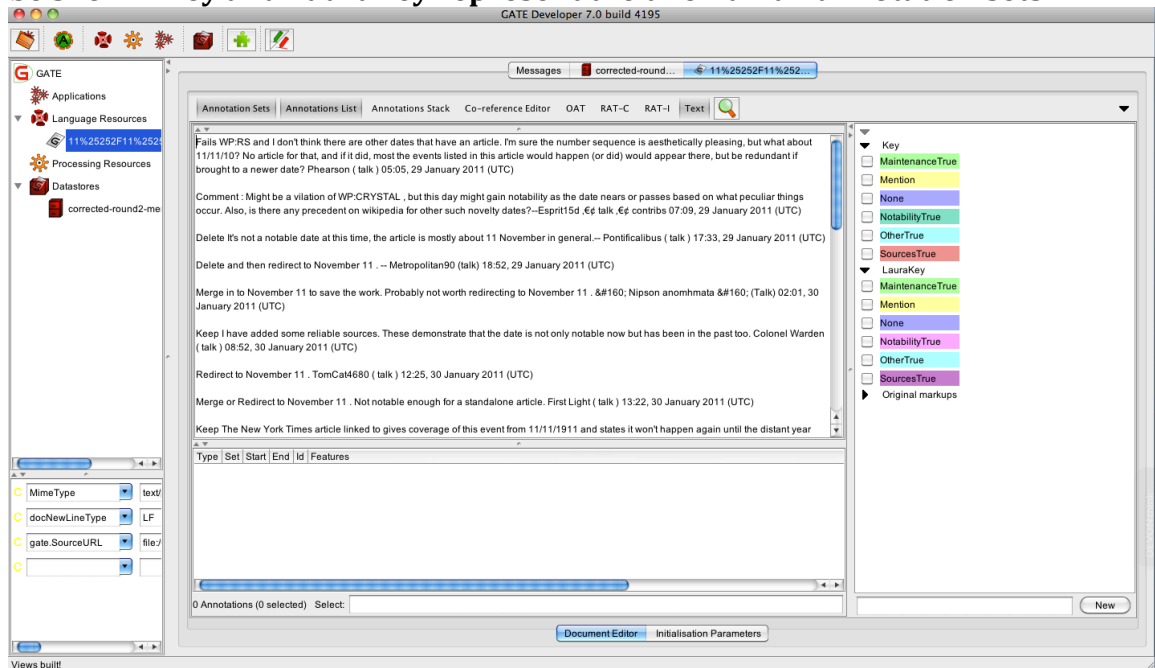
4. Clicking on the name of the datastore shows its contents:

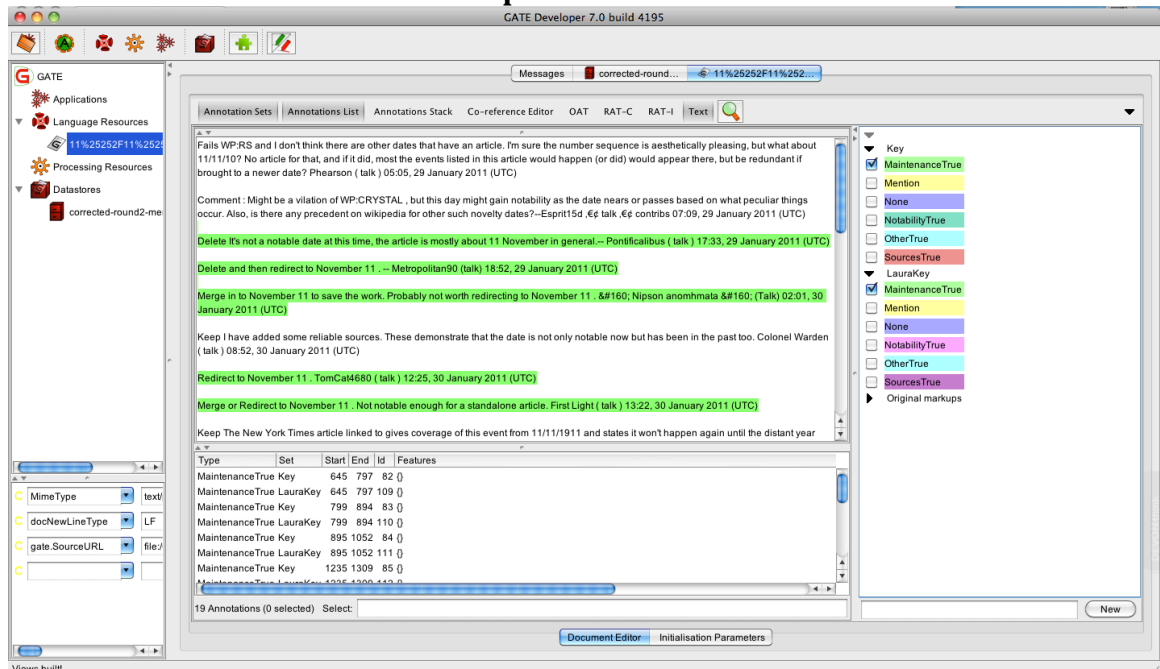

5. Clicking on a document adds it to language resources (opens single document). In the document, the Annotation Sets or Annotation List can be shown. Key and LauraKey represent the two human annotation sets.



6. Annotations can be shown in the text and in the sets by clicking checkboxes in the Annotation Set pane.
